Corca Dhuibhne Creativity & Innovation Hub (Dingle Hub) is looking for ten farmers to take part in a year-long Creative Climate Action project working with an artist on the Dingle Peninsula.

The project, Corca Dhuibhne Inbhuanaithe, will explore the options open to farmers to diversify their farming practice in the face of climate change, focusing on their concerns and the challenges they face.

The chosen farmers will work with artist, Lisa Fingleton, as she develops a better understanding of the issues facing the sector, and the plans the local farming community has for the future. The participating farmers will also undertake eight site visits to places of interest in terms of renewable energy, sustainable enterprises and farming for nature projects. Farmers will be paid a sum for taking part.

We are looking for ten farmers from across the sector: (Dairy, Dry Stock, Sheep, Mixed, & Vegetable Growers), of all ages and levels of experience, from across the peninsula.
